



He later moved to Erice to open his own restaurant but, despite working hard on innovative dishes, he never misses a chance to rediscover the flavors of his childhood, cooking just as his mother taught him. Now, he has his wife Francesca by his side, who will welcome you to their beautiful country home with contagious energy and a big smile. Enchanted by a breathtaking view of the Trapani coastline, you will be immediately smitten with the scent of bread that Vito will bake to serve with appetizers freshly made at the home stove. The highlight will be the 'ncucciatina' of cous cous, a sacred rite that Vito will celebrate with you to join the grains of semolina flavored by an unforgettable fish soup. Simple gestures of a family ritual that Vito and Francesca cherish at their home and that you will have a chance to experience, just a few steps from one of the most stunning medieval villages in Italy!

Erice is a captivating medieval town perched on a hilltop in northwestern Sicily, offering panoramic views of the surrounding countryside and the Tyrrhenian Sea. Known for its well-preserved stone buildings, narrow cobblestone streets, and ancient churches, Erice exudes a timeless charm. Key attractions include the imposing Norman-era Castello di Venere, the beautifully adorned Chiesa Madre, and the quaint squares lined with artisan shops. # DAY FOUR – 17th NOV 2024 MAZARA DEL VALLO - SELINUNTE - SCIACCA

9:00 Morning in Mazara del Vallo with a local guide (35 mins drive)



Although small in size, this city hosts a remarkable number of monumental 11th-century churches and a historic centre of extraordinary beauty. A must-see is the Kasbah, a labyrinthine maze of narrow streets that characterizes the oldest part of the city. With its streets adorned with colourful paintings and house walls decorated with vibrant ceramics and majolica, it immediately gives the impression of being in an Arab country.

Another symbol of Mazara del Vallo is the Norman Arch, the only remaining trace of a castle commissioned by Roger of Hauteville and built after the liberation from Arab rule. From here, you can enjoy a spectacular view of the surrounding sea.



Agrigento and Private Guided Tour of the archaeological site The Valley of The Temples (1 h 15 m drive)




### Eta Agrigento by 10:30 guided tour






# DAY SIX - 19th NOV 2024 RAGUSA, MODICA, NOTO

Key highlights include the magnificent Noto Cathedral, with its grand staircase and ornate facade, and the elegant Palazzo Ducezio.


